

Photography Prize CreArTe 2023

From Fundación Escuela de Solidaridad we want to launch on **MAY 11th-14th 2023** the fourth edition of the Art Social Festival **"CreArTe".**

From our point of view the **Arts represent an infinite space of expression**, relationship and growth, capable of breaking barriers and giving a voice to unfair situations. For this reason, we want to give a **platform for dialogue and experimentation** between Arts and Social Work, that can raise and consolidate innovative and effective methodologies **for social inclusion**.

We would like to invite those organizations and collectives that have consolidated projects and methodologies of social intervention using art as a main tool to participate.

During the festival, that will take place in the city of **Granada**, we are going to develop different workshops for professionals as well as exhibitions of work with Granadian collectives: painting, collage, dancing, performative art, music, photography, pedagogy, flamenco-therapy, art-therapy, theatre, creative writing...

To include more projects and collectives in this edition of the Festival, we have created the **Photography Prize "CreArTe".**

We invite photographers, artists and organizations that use Art as a tool for social inclusion, to participate in the competition considering the competitions rules that are in the attached document.

Competition Rules

- 1. Entry in this competition is at an international level. The competition is open to all professional or amateur photographers from anywhere in the world.
- 2. The photographic technique used for the works entered is at the free choice of the photographer.
- 3. Images must aim to capture moments that show moments of artistic work carried out with collectives in risk of social exclusion.
- 4. Each organization can participate with one photograph maximum.
- 5. The size of each photography must be 30x40cm in JPEG format.
- 1. The competition is in digital format. Therefore, images must be uploaded to an online folder by sending an email to ask for access to festivalkrearte@gmail.com
- 6. Each photograph must go with the Annex I of this document.
- 7. The deadline for submission of digital files ends on 30th April at 00:00 hours.
- 8. During the festival, all the photographs that participate can be shown by the Organisation of the Competition to reproduce on any media or physical or digital format, respecting the authorship of the works and for non-profit purposes.
- 9. Prizewinners competitors give the authorization to the organization of the festival to reproduce on any media or physical or digital format, provided it is for the purposes of promoting or disseminating the competition and the organisation, respecting the authorship of the works and for non-profit purposes.
- 10. There will be an admission and selection jury, and another final classification jury, the latter made up of photographers, artists, and chargers of renowned prestige in the areas of photography, arts and social work, who will be responsible for awarding the prizes. Prizes may under no circumstances remain unawarded. The decision of the jury is not open to appeal.
- 11. The final decision of the jury will be made public, on date 14th of May 2023, as a way of closure of the Festival CreArTe.
- 12. The prize granted, still being negotiated with the institutions, will consist in the publication of the photographies, as well as the project they belong to, in different public places, in order to announce the project. Apart from that, each photograph will receive the next amounts:

A. Popular Jury: 100 €B. Scientific Jury: 100 €

13. Entry in this competition implies full and complete acceptance of these rules.
